Introduction

This report sets out the Stanbic Bank Botswana Limited (SBBL) quarterly capital disclosers in accordance with the Basel II guidelines on the Revised International Convergence of Capital Measurement and Capital Standards for Botswana. The main purpose of this disclosure is to supplement the minimum requirements (Pillar 1) and Supervisory Review Process (Pillar 2) to influence the level of capital and risk assessment processes.

During the quarter ending September 2022, the Bank remained adequately capitalised recording a Capital Adequacy Ratio (CAR) of 18.24% an improvement from 16.18% reported in Q2:2022. The increase on our capital supply is due to subordinated debt issued in July of P215m following a redemption of P200m in June 2022.

The currency used in this report is Botswana Pula and the lowest denomination is in thousands (P'000) unless otherwise stated.
